CAMP INFORMATION:

- **Camp Hours:**

From 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.; however, the morning Coaching Clinics take place from 9 - 11:30, and Jump Start K is from 9 – noon.

- **Location of Camps:**

Only Coaching Clinics, Creative Choice, Path to Success in Middle School, Jump Start II, and ACT/PSAT prep course will take place at the Rosary Campus. Arrival (no earlier than 8:45) and dismissal (no later than 11:45/3:15) will take place in front of the Favrot Fine Arts Center at 4521 Carondelet St. Summer Fun Day Camp, Summer Hearts Day Camp, Sports and More for Boys, Joyful Journey, Creative Hearts (sessions 1 and 2), Cheer Camp, Theater Camp, Think Outside the Box, and Jump Start K and I will be held at the Mater Campus, 4301 St. Charles Ave., at the corner of Napoleon and St. Charles Ave. Enter on Gen. Pershing St.

- **Before-Camp Care:**

Begins at 7:45 a.m. every morning only at the Mater Campus. Campers arriving between 7:45 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. will be placed in Before-Care and billed accordingly (\$7.00 per day/\$30.00 per week prepaid). Parking is available in the lot across from the school on Gen. Pershing for the Mater Campus. Campers may also be dropped off in the carpool line on Gen. Pershing. Parents should escort our Summer Hearts campers to their classrooms. Coaching Clinics, Creative Choice, and Jump Start II campers may be dropped off in front of the Favrot Fine Arts Center at the Rosary Campus no earlier than 8:45. Before -Care for Middle School campers will take place at the Mater Campus from 7:45 – 8:45; then, they will be walked to the Rosary Campus.

- **After-Camp Care:**

begins at 3:15 every afternoon and ends at 5:30 p.m. at the Mater Campus; carpool dismissal will begin at 2:50 p.m. at both campuses. Please remain in your car and place the carpool sign on your dashboard. At the Mater Campus, the carpool line forms along General Pershing; the carpool line at the Rosary Campus forms on Carondelet St. Parents of our Summer Hearts campers should park and enter the building to pick up their children. After 3:15, Middle School campers will be escorted to the Mater Campus for After-Care. The prepaid weekly fee is \$65, or the drop-in rate is \$7.00/hour.

- **Apparel:**

All campers should wear their new blue camp T-shirt to camp every day. Creative Choice campers should wear a camp T-shirt on Wednesdays, and theater campers may also wear their theater T-shirt to camp. The red camp T-shirt for the Summer Hearts campers is optional.

- **Schedules:**

Campers' schedules contain information about field trips and on-campus activities. Please check every morning. Tennis and swim lessons take place at the Paradise Manor Community Club in Harahan on Mondays and Thursdays if you have enrolled your child in these options. If your child is old enough to enroll in tennis lessons at the Paradise Manor Community Club, please make sure he/she wears tennis shoes to camp; tennis rackets will be provided. Schedules for the following week of day camp will be emailed the Friday before. Creative Hearts and Creative Choice schedules will be emailed at the end of May.

- **Lunch:**

Lunch is included in the camp tuition. **Menu for week one is attached.**

- **Snacks:**

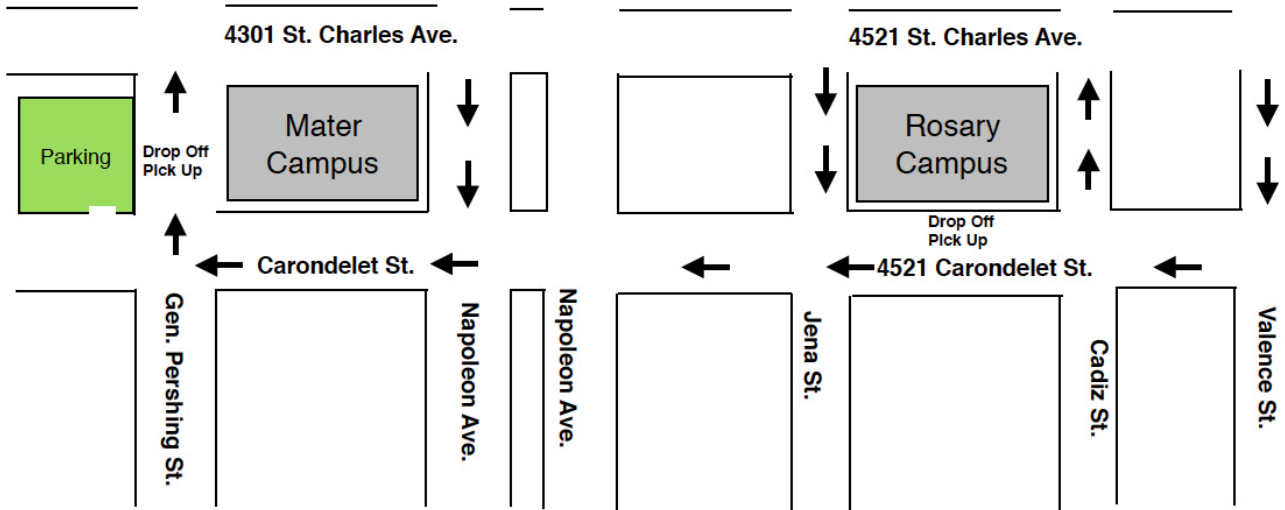
